Sudhakar Selvaraj is an Associate Professor at the Department of Psychiatry & Behavioral Sciences at UTHSC-Houston (UTHealth). He directs the depression research program focusing on the underlying pathophysiology of depressive disorders to identify biomarkers to stratify and individualize treatment. His research utilizes multimodal brain imaging (MRI, positron emission tomography, PET), psychopharmacology, and neuromodulation. His research is funded by NIH, foundation, and industry grants. He has >85 papers, a neuroimaging-focused book titled "Mood Disorders: Brain Imaging and Therapeutic Implications", book chapters and he is an Editorial Board Member, Journal of Affective Disorders. He is a Fellowship, Royal College of Psychiatrists, member of the Society of Biological Psychiatry, American Society of Clinical Psychopharmacology and American College of Neuropsychopharmacology.
